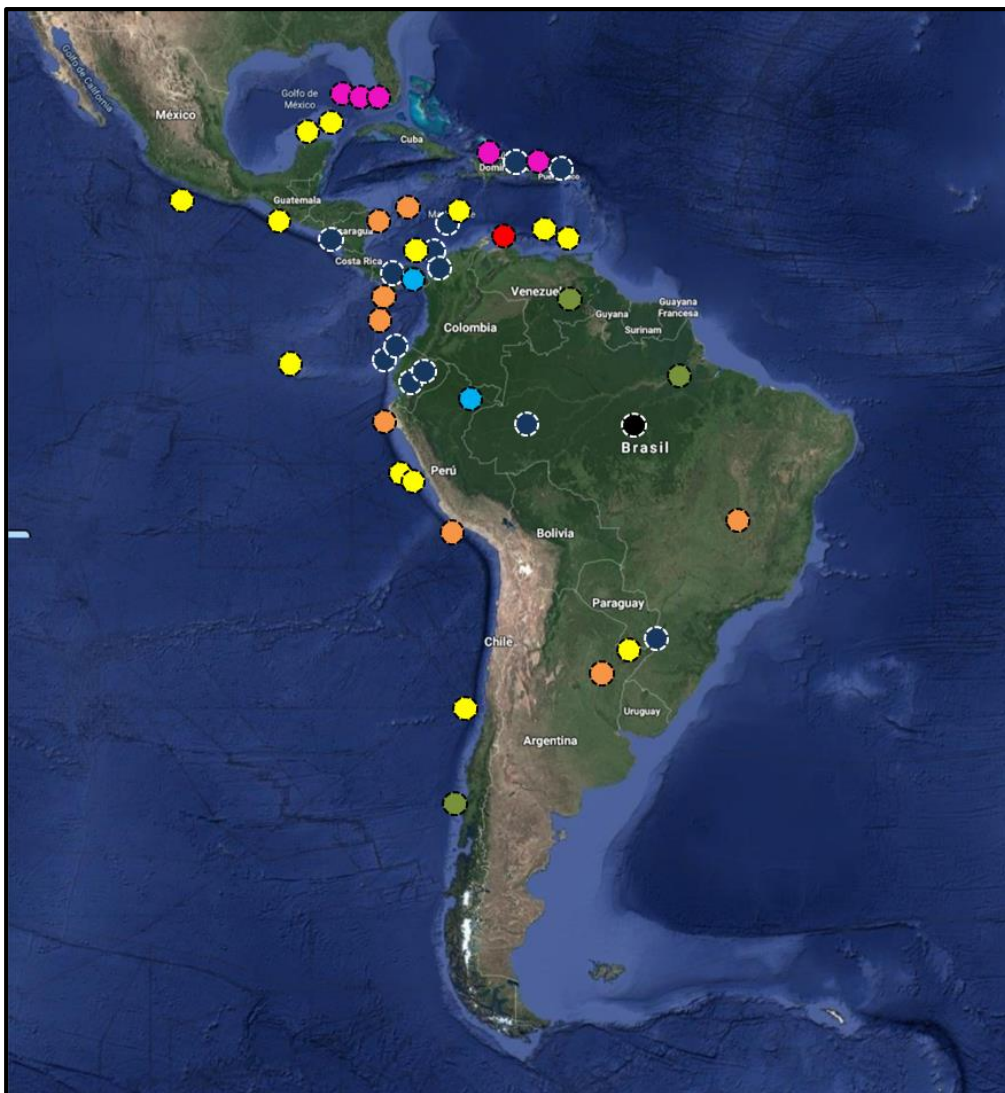

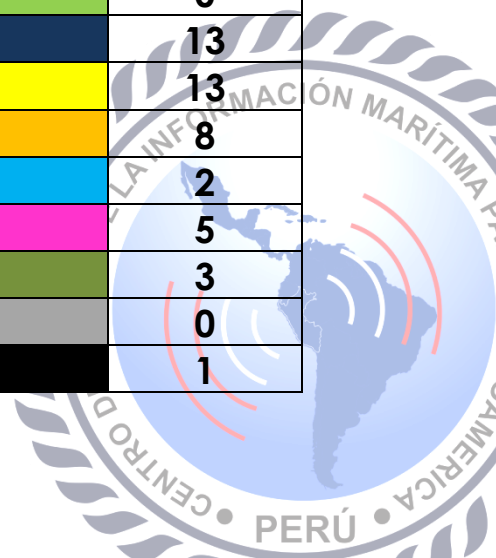

## Pillage, Armed Robbery and Piracy at Sea (PARPS)

1) **Date: May 2 – Violent Robbery/ Lake Area/ TWO people dead/ Lake Maracaibo - Venezuela**

A criminal gang attacked FOUR fishermen during their fishing trip, leaving TWO people dead. The event occurred in Lake Maracaibo, Miranda municipality, on the Eastern Coast - Venezuela.

## DRUG TRAFFICKING (DT)

1) **Date: April 28 – Drugs / Maritime Area / FIVE people arrested / Cocaine hydrochloride (5.5 tons) / Morrosquillo Gulf - Colombia**

The Colombian Air Force, the Ecuadorian Navy, the National Aeronaval Service of Panama and the Interagency Joint Task Force of the Southern Command of the United States, intercepted 3 vessels carrying 5.5 tons of cocaine hydrochloride and detained FIVE people. The operation occurred 120 miles from the Morrosquillo Gulf, Caribbean Sea – Colombia.

2) **Date: April 28 – Drugs / Maritime Area / Cocaine hydrochloride (116 kilos) / Ports of Barranquilla and Zungo in Urabá - Colombia**

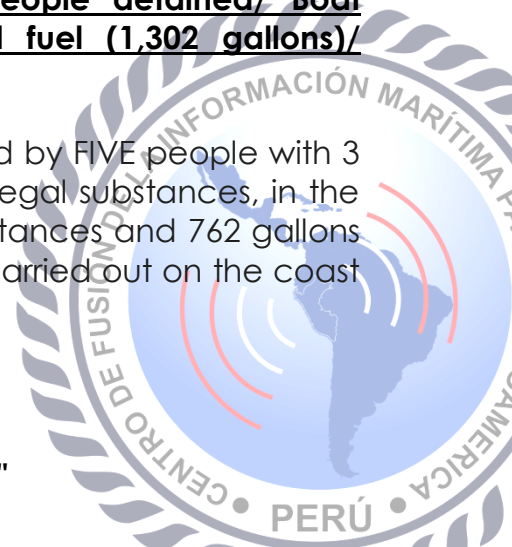
The Colombian Anti-Narcotics Directorate seized 65 kilos of cocaine hydrochloride that was going to be placed in the hull of a boat bound for the port of Antwerp in Belgium and 51 kilos were hidden in a container bound for the city of Southampton in England. The operations occurred in the ports of Barranquilla and Zungo in Urabá - Colombia.

3) **Date: April 28 – Drugs/ Maritime Area/ THIRTEEN people detained/ Boat “VALENTINA”/ Illicit substances (861 packages) and fuel (1,302 gallons)/ Ecuador**

The Ecuadorian Navy intercepted 2 vessels, one crewed by FIVE people with 3 outboard motors, 540 gallons of fuel, 17 packages of illegal substances, in the other vessel EIGHT people, 844 packages of illegal substances and 762 gallons were detained made out of fuel. The operations were carried out on the coast of Esmeralda - Ecuador.

**4) Date: April 29 – Drugs/ River Environment/ Marijuana (196 kilos)/ Paraná River, Puerto Iguazú - Argentina**

The Argentine Naval Prefecture seized 196 kilos of marijuana that were being transported on a boat. The event occurred in the Paraná River, Puerto Iguazú - Argentina.

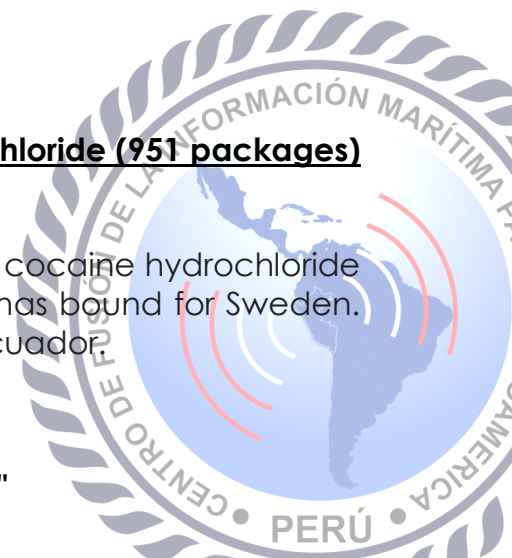

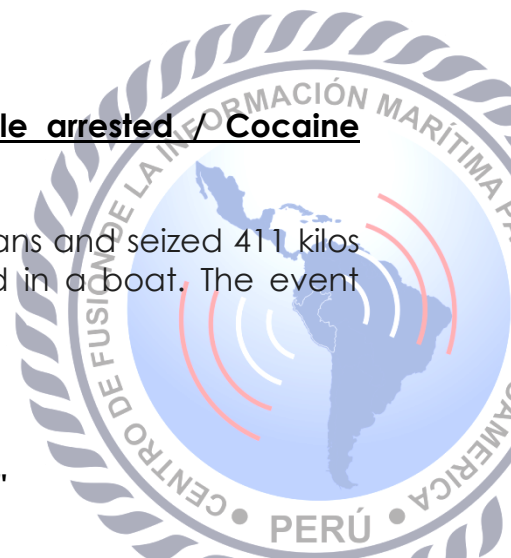

### MARITIME INCIDENTS (IM)

**1) Date: April 29 – Adrift / Maritime Area / THREE people rescued / “KAYAK” type boat / Isla Múcura, Cartagena - Colombia**

The Colombian Navy rescued THREE people who were adrift in a "kayak" type boat. The event occurred off Isla Múcura, Cartagena - Colombia.

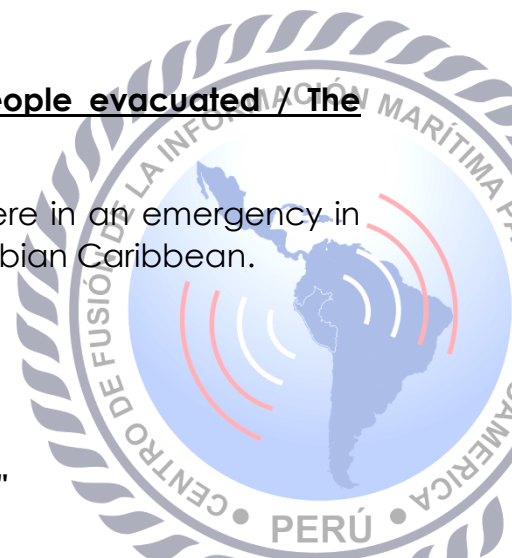

**ILLEGAL, UNREPORTED AND UNREGULATED (IUU) FISHING**

**1) Date: April 28 - Illegal Fishing / Maritime Area / Vessel "CAP DERVIN" / Queen conch (35 kilos) / Cayo Serrana Island, San Andrés - Colombia**

The Colombian Navy intercepted the vessel "CAP DERVIN" that was carrying 35 kilos of queen conch, which was illegally extracted in the general area of Isla Cayo Serrana, San Andrés - Colombia.

**2) Date: April 28 - Illegal Fishing / Maritime Area / Vessels "LADY KEVAHUA" and "TRES HERMANOS VI" / Sea cucumber (339 pounds) and green turtles (26 units) / Municipality of Bluefields and Barra de Crucira – Nicaragua**

The Nicaraguan Army seized 26 green turtles of the "Chelonia Mydas" species and 339 pounds of brown sea cucumbers of the "holothuridae" species. The incident occurred 8 nautical miles from the municipality of Bluefields and 2 nautical miles from the Crucira Bar – Nicaragua.

Personnel from the San Juan de Marcona Port Captaincy and the Maritime Patrol Boat B.A.P. "Río Chira" (PM-223), intervened in the fishing vessel "MI VENTURITA", which was carrying a minor and 4 specimens of the species known as "Dark Dolphin" and "Common Dolphin", prohibited hydrobiological resources. 1. The sailors who become aware of or suffer any incident may share the information with the IFC-Peru for Latin America in order to analyze and report the information received.
2. It is recommended to all navigators that before an event that affects the safety of people, ships or cargo, consider that it is of utmost importance for the authorities to have the description of the facts and the alleged suspects, and if possible, take films and / or photographs of them. Where available, they shall provide the digital images they capture of the incident to the authorities of the coastal State for appropriate investigation.

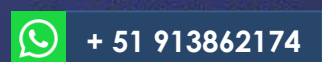
